INFORMATION FOR PROSPECTIVE MEMBERS OF THE PADEL SECTION

Thank you for your interest in the padel section of our tennis club. Our court is into its second year of use now, following its build in October and then opening for play in mid-November 2019. We are hoping to build a further 2 courts this year.

A club for all

In our newly formed Padel section of Epsom LTC we welcome all new members whether you are an adult or a junior. We are a local club, with a friendly relaxed atmosphere and great facilities that encourage both tennis and padel all year round.

For adults

Our floodlit padel court is bookable from 8am, throughout the day, with the last booking ending at 10.00pm. Bookings may be made for up to 90 minutes in 30 minute intervals. Further information will be given to you regarding our on-line court booking system when you have joined the club.

We have social padel tennis (for peak members currently) on Thursday evenings and on Saturday afternoons. To enable some friendly competitive play with fellow members we have set up a series of box leagues. These leagues have 5 to 6 pairings and run for around 5 weeks before they are reorganised and reissued. You may either play with a partner of your choosing or we will pair you with another member if you could prefer.

For juniors

We offer both peak and off-peak membership for juniors. Juniors have the same rights as adult members when using the courts in accordance with our Junior Charter. We have an appointed Club Welfare/Children's Officer whose details may be found on the junior noticeboard in the Clubhouse.

Our facilities

We currently have one floodlit padel court (with the expectation of increasing this to three later this year) and also 12 tennis courts of varying surfaces – 7 of these are also floodlit. Our clubhouse has a shower and changing rooms. We have a bar for social events and there is a bar available in the neighbouring cricket clubhouse too. Both clubhouses can be used for social events.

Social events and tournaments

The club has a social events calendar for the year with many events open to both tennis and padel members. Within both the tennis and padel sections, we have friendly tournaments and our official club tournament, and we also have seasonal handicap tournaments that run during the year for tennis members. We hope to include seasonal handicap tournaments for the padel section this year also.

What's App group

We have set up a What's App group to enable members to informally arrange padel matches with other members. Further details will be given to you when you join the padel section.

Membership

We have 2 membership rates for our padel section – peak and off peak. Our subscription rates are fully inclusive of both court hire and the use of floodlights. Should you require any further information please do not hesitate to ask.

* Peak membership: Use of court at all times, on both weekdays and weekends, between 8am and 10pm, except during club organised sessions or matches. Court should be booked using the online court booking system. Play for teams and in Club tournaments

** Off-peak membership Use of court Monday to Friday (including Bank Holidays) between 8am to 6pm, except during club organised sessions or matches. Court should be booked using the online court booking system. Play for teams if matches take place within these times. Play in Club tournaments at other times of payment of a visitor's fee
