INFORMATION FOR PROSPECTIVE MEMBERS OF THE PADEL SECTION

Thank you for your interest in the padel section of our tennis club. With effect from the second week in October, we will have three excellent all-weather padel courts.

A club for all

In our Padel section at Epsom LTC we welcome all new members whether you are an adult or a junior. We are a local club, with a friendly relaxed atmosphere and great facilities that encourage both tennis and padel all year round.

For adults

Our initial floodlit padel court, and the two further courts coming into play in October 2021, are bookable from 9.00am, throughout the day, with the last booking ending at 10.00pm. Bookings may be made for up to 90 minutes in 30 minute intervals. Further information will be given to you regarding our on-line court booking system when you have joined the club. Peak members may use the courts 7 days a week between 9.00am and 10.00pm and our off-peak members court usage is from Monday to Friday between 9.00am and 4.00pm.

We have several social padel tennis sessions during the week and at the weekend also. The evening and weekend sessions are for peak members, but we will also have a weekday session for off-peak members (and peak will also be welcome) from mid-October. We will be re-establishing our box leagues in the near future to enable some friendly competitive play with fellow members. Further details will be sent to all members when we are in a position to restart them.

For juniors

We offer both peak and off-peak membership for juniors. Juniors have the same rights as adult members when using the courts in accordance with our Junior Charter. We have an appointed Club Welfare/Children's Officer whose details may be found on the junior noticeboard in the Clubhouse.

Our facilities

From October 2021 we will have three all-weather padel courts. We also have 11 tennis courts of varying surfaces – 7 of these are also floodlit. Our clubhouse has a shower and changing rooms. We have a bar for social

events and there is a bar available in the neighbouring cricket clubhouse too. Both clubhouses can be used for social events.

Social events and tournaments

The club has a social events calendar for the year with many events open to both tennis and padel members. Within both the tennis and padel sections, we have friendly tournaments and our official club tournament, and we also have seasonal handicap tournaments that run during the year for both padel and tennis members.

What's App group

We have set up a What's App group to enable members to informally arrange padel matches with other members. Further details will be given to you when you join the padel section.

Membership

We have 2 membership rates for our padel section – peak and off-peak. Our subscription rates are fully inclusive of both court hire and the use of floodlights. Should you require any further information please do not hesitate to ask.

* Peak membership: Use of courts at all times, on both weekdays and weekends, between 9am and 10pm, except during club organised sessions or matches. Courts should be booked using the online court booking system. Play for teams and in Club tournaments

** Off-peak membership: Use of courts Monday to Friday (including Bank Holidays) between 9am and 4pm, except during club organised sessions or matches. Courts should be booked using the online court booking system. Play for teams if matches take place within these times. Play in Club tournaments at other times of payment of a visitor's fee
